PURPOSE

5. Demonstrate growth in spiritual disciplines, as a necessary foundation for effective ministry.
6. Demonstrate competency in interpreting and communicating the message of the Christian scriptures appropriate to the culture.
7. Evaluate the functions and principles of Christian formation within and beside the local church.
8. Demonstrate the basic skills necessary to effectively equip and encourage people in local ministry.

3. Demonstrate growth in spiritual disciplines as a necessary foundation to live a Christ-like life.

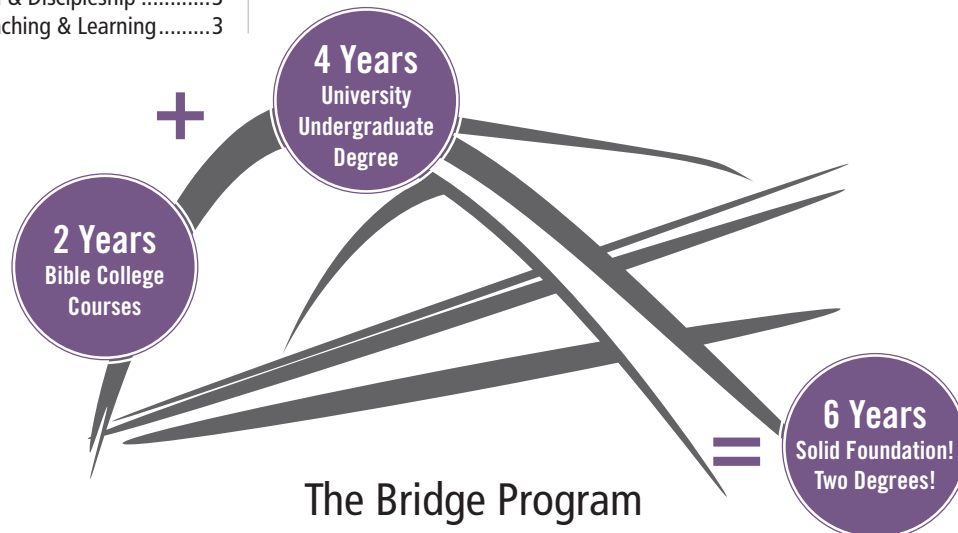
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The Bridge Program

The B.R.E. — General Studies is designed for the student who wishes to prepare for non-traditional ministry. It allows a student to complete a Bible College degree by spending two years at Alberta Bible College and transferring in up to two years (64 hours) of credit from another chosen institution. In order to complete all Alberta Bible College courses in two years, a student will need to declare this choice of program at the beginning of the third semester.

Up to two years are accepted as transfer into Kings University College and Trinity Western University. Students have also combined this with credits from SAIT, University of Calgary, Dalhousie University, Mount Royal University and several more.
