Information on Obtaining a Canadian Study Permit:

To be eligible to study in Canada

1. You must have been accepted by a school, college, university or other educational institution in Canada.
2. You must prove that you have enough money to pay for your:
 - o tuition fees,
 - o living expenses for you and any family members who come with you to Canada, and
 - o return transportation for you and any family members who come with you to Canada.
3. You must be a law-abiding citizen with no criminal record and not be a risk to the security of Canada. You may have to provide a police clearance in accordance with IRCC regulations.
4. You must be in good health and willing to complete a medical examination, if necessary.
5. You must satisfy an immigration officer that you will leave Canada when you have completed your studies.

International students must meet federal government requirements and be issued a study permit to pursue higher education at Alberta Bible College. Failure to comply with the standards of the Government of Canada (IRCC) and the compulsory qualifications at Alberta Bible College will result in termination of the application process. **Any and all questions pertaining to immigration matters must be directed to IRCC and its representatives only.**
