## **ReReading Scripture**

ReReading Scripture is a free Zoom-based class ABC offers on Saturdays, 10 to 1130 AM (MT). ReReading Scripture was created by our president, Dr. Stan Helton, when he was in pastoral ministry to fill the gap often felt in congregational life that Sunday School and Bible Classes once filled. ReReading Scripture is an interactive learning platform that engages literary, historical, and theological background as a means to a more holistic reading of the Bible. In short, this is the Bible study for those who want more! Usually ReReading focuses on a close reading of the Bible. So we have covered large topics like the Old Testament as a single book but we have also focused on smaller books, such as Jonah or Ephesians. We do occasionally take on special

topics important for Bible study, like a look at history of what happened between the Old and New Testament. Everything we do in ReReading is to help us become better readers of Scripture. ReReading Scripture will begin a fourweek series February 20 on the Sermon on Mount. The Sermon on the Mount stands as a pivotal teaching from Jesus and Dr. Stan will contend this story offers the "politic" of Jesus, that is, the way Jesus expects his



disciples to interact with God, each other, and those outside the Christian community.

Jesus offers us an alternative politic to the one being offered by either the right or the left (regardless of which country you live in). Please come and learn with us.
