- A willingness to engage in the lives of students, their families, and young adults
- Able to teach/preach and prepare engaging Bible studies
- Excellent interpersonal and written/verbal communication skills
- Strong planning and organization skills
- Able to build and maintain supportive relationships and effectively lead others in a Christ-like manner
- Formal ministry training and/or experience in youth/young adult ministry

- Lead, oversee and grow the church's youth and young adult ministry
- Equip, mentor, shepherd, and disciple students and young adults to encourage their spiritual growth
- Develop positive and supportive relationships with students, their parents, and young adults
- Plan and organize events/activities in keeping with ministry goals
- Prepare and deliver engaging Bible studies
- Communicate consistently with students, their parents, and young adults
- Creatively share program plans through social media, website updates, and other means
