I recently began teaching at ABC after having graduated with my MA in Theological Studies from Wycliffe College in Toronto. Making the transition from student to teacher is certainly a daunting one. It is almost as if all your insecurities have been waiting for the perfect moment to rear their ugly heads, and finally the moment has arrived. At the same time however, this transition has been extremely exciting and profoundly rewarding. After having invested myself so diligently in practical ministry work and academic studies for so many years, God is now graciously giving me the fearful task of communicating biblical truth to new, emerging Christian leaders. This is where the reward in teaching truly resides for me – seeing God use me in small ways to shape and mould his people such that they can then go and do the same thing for others. In this sense, teaching at a place like ABC is quite different from teaching in other contexts. Whilst all education has a kind of mentor/mentee flavour to it, Christian education is, in essence, discipleship. As I help my students grow academically in terms of both knowledge and skills, I am ultimately equipping them to follow Christ wholeheartedly and to reproduce other faithful followers of Christ.

In this season I am beginning to discern that God may be calling me to the vocation of theological teaching in a much more involved and long-term sense than I had ever previously imagined. I feel very blessed to be able to do this in a place like ABC, where high quality academic theology and real, heartfelt faith and love go hand in hand. I am extremely grateful to David Ford, our Academic Dean, for his guidance and mentorship during the past six months. As I enter into the role of discipling students in the classroom, I too need to be discipled by those more experienced than myself. David has filled this need in a crucial way, always going above and beyond the call of duty. As we hit our 90th year of Christian higher education, I am very excited to be a part this beautiful work of God we call Alberta Bible College.


