
Julie Bae, Diploma of Christian Ministry: Biblical Studies


Kaithlyne Marcos, Bachelor of Christian Ministry: Biblical Studies

Brittney Neubauer, Diploma: Counselling and Ministry


Brittney is focusing on the women's ministry that she started at her church and in the future her hope is to do a church plant



Linda Pagoda, Bachelor of Christian Ministry: Counselling



GRADUATION CEREMONY

Alberta Bible College held its 2023 Graduation Ceremony with great success on Saturday, April 29th. 18 graduates, including 4 certificates, 5 diplomas, and 9 bachelor's degrees, celebrated their achievements. The event began with a traditional procession of staff, professors, and students in regalia. Adjunct professor of history, Dan Hardock, led those in attendance in prayer. Academic Dean, David Ford, then welcomed everyone and read ABC's land acknowledgement. Pam Baribeault, adjunct professor in Biblical Studies, did the scripture reading of Matthew 5:17-21.

Following this, Pete Justine, worship minister at Bow Valley Christian Church, led the congregation in worship and presented a new song he personally composed for the graduates. Later, President Stan Helton introduced the keynote speaker, David Ross, who delivered an inspirational address centered on the theme of transformation. Ross shared his personal journey with Alberta Bible College as both a student and faculty member. He emphasized the graduates' path of healing, formation, and transformation, in alignment with the biblical text that Baribeault had earlier read. He challenged the graduates, reminding them of their role as Christ's agents of transformation in the world. Ross concluded by reciting a verse from Romans 15:13, encouraging graduates to move forward in faith: "May the God of hope fill you with all the joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."

Linda Pogoda delivered the Valedictorian address, thanking family, friends, professors, and staff for their support, assistance, and care throughout the graduates' journeys. As a member of the "COVID class," Pogoda acknowledged the sacrifices made to attain spiritual and intellectual growth, including navigating online and hybrid classes. She cited the beatitudes and personal stories of the graduates to illustrate their accomplishments and ended her speech by expressing confidence in the graduates' ability to continue to shine as lights of Christ.

The ceremony concluded with adjunct professor, Katie Pearn, leading a prayer of guidance, and Cory Pytlarz, Student Development Dean, concluding with a benediction before everyone joined in a time of fellowship, mingling, and celebration. Refreshments were enjoyed by all, and plenty of photos were taken to capture the memories of this significant milestone. Throughout the event, God was glorified and His name praised.
