


How to Search for Scriptures and Verses in ATLA

Step 1) Access to Bible Journals.

Go to the [Alberta Bible College \(ABC\) Library website](http://abccampus.ca/current-students/library/) and select [Research Resources](#) to access Bible Journals.



Then, scroll down to **Bible Journals** and click on the link, [Search our Bible Journals](#). The link will take you to the database (ATLA scripture search).





Step 2) Click on [Atla Scripture Search](#) on your left sidebar to open a page with the books of the bible.




Once you click on **Atla Scripture Search**, the page should look like this:



Step 3) Find the scriptures.

- a) Go through the scriptures by clicking the arrow sign “ > ” until you find the one you are looking for.




Click on the Expand button (white + symbol in the blue background) for the scripture you want to get all the articles related to the subject (scripture), and choose whichever chapter you are looking for. Once you click on the specific chapter, the page will take you to a verse list for that chapter.

For instance,

Let's say, you want to find any online journals about **Psalms chapter 1, verse 3!**

Click on [Psalms](#) → [Chapter 1](#) → [Verse 3](#) → [Add to search](#) → [Search](#)

You will see all articles that this database has on the verse 3.



b) The articles that come up will be about the passage mentioned. Therefore, it will also include articles that cover a wider reach than just what you searched particularly. As seen in the image below, there is an article that covers the whole of Psalm Chapter 1, not just verse 3. Go through the data and pick the most relevant journals for your study.
