We are a multicultural and multi-generational congregation with a mix of urban and rural adherents, typically welcoming 120 to 180 attendees on a Sunday morning. We are affiliated with the [Canadian Baptists of Western Canada \(CBWC\)](#) and partner with [Canadian Baptist Ministries \(CBM\)](#) and several mission partners and local ministries.

Our church community is committed to being welcoming and relational—helping people build meaningful connections with God and with one another. A guiding value for us comes from our founding pastor, the late Rev.
