Job Overview

As a Music Director Intern at Dalhousie Church, you will play an important role in supporting and enhancing our worship ministry & community engagements (the exact role will be tailored based on applicants interests and skills). This position offers a unique opportunity for hands-on experience in music leadership, event coordination, and creative ministry projects.

Through this internship, you will receive mentorship from experienced church leaders, gain hands-on experience in organizing worship services and events, and contribute to building a welcoming and engaging worship environment for the church community.

Tasks and Responsibilities - may include the following

Worship

- Assisting in leading corporate worship through song 1-2 times per month (including multiple rehearsals mid-week)
- Managing the scheduling and coordinating of 40+ volunteers
- Contributing to the planning worship sets and service flow
- Connecting with pastors/leaders to ensure proper communication and collaboration for weekly activities
- Attending weekly staff meetings
- Exploring creative responses and alternative forms of worship
- Researching new music
- Organizing and taking inventory of musical equipment
- Training on software such as ProPresenter 7, Final Cut Pro X (offered on-site)
- Printing/collating worship music each week
- Building into volunteer relationships through direct communication and face-to-face connections
- Basic training on how to run an A&H SQ-7 sound console (offered on-site)
- Basic training on how to run and mix a livestream (offered on-site)
- Learning our technical infrastructure to solve problems when they arise
- Developing and mentoring a youth worship team
- Learning to lead in a way that makes it easy for others to follow; learning in a safe environment with the ability to adapt and grow

Community Engagement

- Managing/scheduling/communication/collaboration with our Integration Teams (ushers, greeters, welcome centre)
- Recruiting new volunteers for our Integration Teams
- Developing a safety plan for emergency situations
- Coordinating and directing a special video project for Mother's Day and Father's Day
- Taking on a supplementary role with our Blessing Bag project for the homeless
- Co-writing policies with mentor/supervisor for various activities (when needed)
- Coordinating our annual community Pancake Breakfast
