 - Assist with creating activities, games, and lessons for the camp.

- **Weekly Programming:**
 - Assist with weekly Sunday programming for children, from setup to tear down.
 - Help prepare teaching materials, crafts, and activities.
 - Engage with children and parents, helping create a warm, welcoming environment.
- **Outreach & Community:**
 - Support and staff community-facing events and outreach initiatives throughout the summer.
 - Assist with event setup, greet families, and engage kids with fun activities.
- **Administration:**
 - Help with administrative tasks like record-keeping, volunteer coordination, and communication with families.
 - Assist in organizing resources, maintaining supply inventories, and updating databases.
