Job Overview

As a Youth Program Intern at Dalhousie Church, you will play a crucial role in supporting and enhancing our youth ministry (elementary through high school age, based on applicants interests and skills). This internship offers a unique opportunity for hands-on experience, allowing you to collaborate with pastors and youth leaders while contributing to the development and implementation of engaging programs for our vibrant youth community.

This internship provides mentorship from experienced pastors and youth leaders, hands-on experience in planning and executing youth-focused events, and the opportunity to contribute to the growth and development of the church's youth ministry.

Tasks and Responsibilities - may include the following

Lesson Planning and Curriculum Preparation:

- Collaborate with the Youth Director and the youth ministry team to develop and implement engaging lesson plans based right out of scripture. Assist in preparing curriculum materials, ensuring alignment with the mission of Christ and spreading the gospel.

Event Coordination:

- Host and coordinate events for youth during the summer. Plan, organize, and execute various youth-focused activities and outings, creating memorable experiences for our community of young people.

Church Organization:

- Support in organizing and maintaining youth ministry spaces within the church. Assist with administrative tasks related to youth events, attendance tracking, and communication to ensure smooth operations.

Pastoral Collaboration:

- Work closely with pastors and youth leaders to understand and support the overall vision and mission of the youth ministry. Attend meetings with pastors to contribute ideas and receive guidance on ministry strategies.

Youth Engagement:

- Foster positive relationships with youth participants, providing mentorship and guidance. Actively participate in youth gatherings to promote a loving, welcoming and fun environment for all.
